### FUJITSU FTR-J2 - ULTRA SMALL HIGH VOLTAGE DC RELAY



Fujitsu Components Europe releases the FTR-J2 relay; the high voltage DC power relay. Power is the keyword to describe the FTR-J2. The power is demonstrated in the relay's capability of switching 450V DC, 10A. Having the capability of switching these high voltages one could expect that the relay dimensions would be very large but the FTR-J2 surprises because of its small size. The relay measures just 24x23.5x27 mm. To be able to switch high DC voltages in these small dimensions, Fujitsu has designed two strong permanent magnets in the relay. This magnetic provision is installed to extinguish the severe breaking arc.
