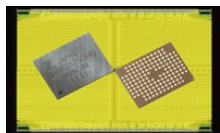

FUJITSU LAUNCHES WORLD'S FIRST 125°C SPEC. LOW POWER MEMORY FOR SiPs

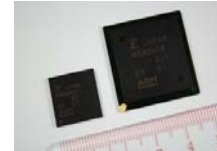

FUJITSU RELEASES NEW HD TRANSCODER ICs

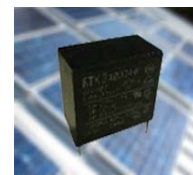

FUJITSU'S OPTICAL FIBRE INSTALLATION LINKS E-MERLIN SEVEN-TELESCOPE NETWORK



Fujitsu Telecommunications reports that its long-distance optical fibre installation has enabled the University of Manchester's Jodrell Bank Observatory to receive the first signals from its e-MERLIN network of seven radio telescopes, which are located around the UK up to 217km apart. Fujitsu's Carrier Services teams handled the construction of the civils infrastructure (using both traditional trenching methods and trenchless technology) and the subsequent fibre installation of some 80km of new fibre for e-MERLIN, linking into existing dark-fibre resources, with the project illustrating the company's infrastructure planning and implementation capabilities.
