Customer's Challenge

Bord Gáis Eíreann was established under the 1976 Gas Act and it is their responsibility to transmit, distribute and support natural gas and electricity in Ireland. The company is a major player in Ireland's gas market, supplying almost 500000 homes and 18,000 business customers. Bord Gáis is owned by the Irish Government however it is a commercial entity and successfully competes in a very competitive and increasingly deregulated energy market in Ireland. Bord Gáis has capitalised on the deregulation of the energy market and has already captured 7% of market share.

With the advent of market deregulation Bord Gáis decided it had to enhance its business processes to meet the criteria set down to:

- i. Participate in the market
- ii. To retain market share

The challenges facing Bord Gáis:

- The company wanted to have a high level view of performance & cash flow whilst encouraging consistent processes across the Organisation.
- Bord Gáis needed to access the account information of each business unit to ensure compliance with discrete profit & loss reporting for each area of the business.
- Bord Gáis wanted to reduce overheads and process cycle times through automating processes and business flows.

To address these challenges Bord Gáis formed a specialist team who together with Fujitsu, implemented a variety of Oracle Modules applying best business practices and introducing a common data model and standards within the Finance and Procurement functions.
