Introduction




- eXtensible Business Reporting Language
 - Standard for electronic exchange of financial data
 - Interactive use by people
 - Allows industry and regional adoption
 - Developed by an international non-profit consortium
 - Based on XML
- Adoption
 - Already adopted in various countries
 - Adoption flow from East to West
 - SEC All public companies to file in XBRL by 2011
 - SBR Australia –XBRL for reports to government
 - Transition to IFRS








Preparer: Before XBRL

Phase 1


Add minimal application to capture report data and add XBRL support.

For example

- •HTML or forms based applications that mimic current operations
- •Data could be transformed into a more open standard or even XBRL

Preparer: With XBRL





Phase 2


Increase the depth of the XBRL implementation

For example

•Identify a subset of data to automatically extract from backoffice systems

Preparer: With XBRL





Phase 3

Embed the XBRL tagging deeper and earlier in the financial supply chain

For example

•Back-office systems are already XBRL aware







Consumer: With XBRL







Best Practices



Investigation

- Educate key personnel on XBRL
- Take stock of current processes and tools
- Assess key infrastructure components

Planning

- Create detailed roadmap
- Identify the resources people and systems
- Determine automation in each stage
- Decide depth of XBRL embedding at each stage






