


# How do I get the printer data?


**Answer:** This is the example of Windows 10.  
(The method is similar on other Windows OS too.)

- (1) Click the Windows Start button.




- (2) Click "Settings".


- (3) Click "Devices".



- (4) Click "Devices and printers".




- (5) Right click on the printer icon.



# How do I get the printer data?




(6) Select the "Printer Properties"




(7) Select the "Ports" tab.

Note: Memorize the original port name.




(8) Check the "FILE" and Click the "Apply" button.



## How do I get the printer data?

(9) Send the print data by your application.


(10) Then, Pop up the dialog as follows.



\* Specify the folder and the file name. Then Click the "Save" button. Finally, the print data will be stored to the specific file.

### ■ Restore the printer setting.

Display the "Ports" dialog box according to the procedure from (1) to (7).



Check the port that memorized by the procedure (7). Then click the "OK" button.

### ■ Data Sending.

The print data will be stored to the specific folder. Send the print data to FIT.

### \*Note

After the sending, it is possible to delete the files.
