





Core IT Modernization: The New Focus for Digital Transformation

Only 18% of organizations have an allencompassing ERP suite with embedded next-gen technologies such as machine learning (ML) and Internet of Things (IoT).






ERP Workloads Are Shifting to the Cloud


ERP Modernization Is Driven by Multidisciplinary Teams






