### The customer

Culloden Primary Academy - A Paradigm Academy School located in Tower Hamlets supporting a growing population of local children, the majority of whom speak English as a second language. The school teaches children aged between the ages of 3-11. The Trust has a simple ethos: that every child is entitled to an outstanding education, with equal access to knowledge, skills, opportunities, aspirations, life chances and dignity.

### The challenge

With the move to Academy status, Culloden Primary Academy wanted to create a more scalable IT platform that could effectively support future growth. As Culloden Primary Academy lease agreement on its existing equipment had recently come to an end, it was the perfect time to explore new opportunities.

“We wanted to build more capacity within Culloden Primary Academy to support our growing ICT demands,” explains Ben Carter, Principal, Culloden Primary Academy. “Our initial research suggested that implementing a server and storage cluster system would be the ideal way to progress.”

Furthermore, Levett Consultancy takes the original Fujitsu solution and wraps it in further customised class leading software from Microsoft, Impero, Symantec and Redstor already built-in. This means it works straight out of the box, enabling Culloden Primary Academy to simply plug it in and be ready to go for continuous, cost-effective availability.

"We have almost 600 pupils and over 100 staff, all of whom rely on technology to bring learning to life and make the classroom more engaging," says Ben Carter. "Unlike the previous server platform, the Fujitsu solution allows us to run over 100 windows devices and 330 Google Chromebooks simultaneously without any detriment to the user experience, making this enhanced learning experience possible."
