

## **Applications Discovery**

### There are multiple definitions for 'application discovery'.

Fujitsu separates this activity into 3 distinct phases:

### Applications Audit

Potentially, only a proportion of your existing applications will continue to be required by your end-users after desktop transformation. Fujitsu can audit your applications by metering levels of usage. Unlike traditional metering, this process only records usage when they are active, giving you a complete overview of your most important enterprise applications.

### Applications Discovery

#### For Fujitsu, Applications Discovery must provide the collateral from which an application can be processed through packaging and testing – often the Achilles heel of most transformation programmes. Fujitsu will identify the current state of applications and then recommend the best way forward so you get a clear and concise view of the progress of each application within the lifecycle.


### Suitability Fujitsu will determine which of your applications are ready to be migrated to your new desktop platform. Some applications may
